

Hygiene concept of the Kestner Gesellschaft in the respective current version 1.9.2020 pursuant to the Ordinance of Lower Saxony on the Reorganisation of Measures against the Spread of the Corona Virus SARS-CoV-2 of 10 July 2020, as amended on 31 July 2020.

Visit of the exhibition

- The minimum distance of 1.5 meters between the persons according to § 1 paragraph (3) sentence 1 and 2 applies.
- During the visit the wearing of a mouth and nose protection is expressly recommended.
- Disinfectant dispensers at important junctions and in the washrooms enable guests to disinfect their hands at any time.
- Throughout the building, the direction of movement is prescribed by a guidance system that avoids encounter traffic. In addition, supervisory staff ensure that the direction of travel is maintained.
- The exhibition halls and ancillary rooms are 1,300 square meters in total. Nevertheless, for safety reasons we have limited the number of participants to 50 visitors at the same time.
- An air conditioning system exchanges room air with fresh air.
- All surfaces and sanitary facilities are regularly cleaned by a cleaning service, and the rooms are ventilated as far as possible (air conditioning).

Events and guided tours

- You can register by e-mail or online, via an automated Doodle query or by phone. The personal data collection and documentation is carried out according to § 4: First name, surname, address, telephone number, appointment slot, as well as the date and time of collection. This avoids queues at the entrance and ensures a fast admission.
- The data will be kept for a period of three weeks after the event and then destroyed.
- The minimum distance of 1.5 meters between the persons according to § 1 paragraph (3) sentence 1 and 2 applies.
- During the visit, the wearing of a mouth and nose protection is mandatory.
- Disinfectant dispensers at important junctions and in the washrooms enable guests to disinfect their hands at any time.
- Throughout the building, the direction of movement is prescribed by a guidance system, which avoids encounter traffic. In addition, supervisory staff ensure that the direction of travel is maintained.
- The exhibition halls and ancillary rooms are 1,300 square meters in total. Nevertheless, for safety reasons we have limited the number of participants to 50 visitors at the same time.
- A seating concept is available for each event.
- An air conditioning system exchanges room air with fresh air.
- All surfaces and sanitary facilities are regularly cleaned by a cleaning service, and the rooms are ventilated as far as possible (air conditioning).

Workshops for Kids

Hygiene concept for "**Kestnerkids machen Kunst**" and "**Kestnerkids goes international**" pursuant to the Ordinance of Lower Saxony on the Reorganisation of Measures against the Spread of the Corona Virus SARS-CoV-2 of 10 July 2020, as amended on 31 July 2020

Measures for the preparation of the event

- There are eight places available.
- To the dates the children must announce themselves up to one week before obligatorily by Mail under kestnerkids@kestnergesellschaft.de. The personal registration includes the child's first name, surname, address and telephone number. The data will be kept for the duration of at least three weeks.
- The exhibition halls and adjoining rooms in which the children move around are 1,300 square meters in total. The studio is 60 square meters. The number of participating children is limited to 8 children, plus 2 teachers.

Procedure and measures during the event

- The children arrive individually in the foyer of the Kestner Gesellschaft and register at the reception with their names.
- When entering the Kestner Gesellschaft, they are obliged to wear a mouth and nose protection from the age of 7.
- The teachers also wear a mask.
- As soon as all eight children have arrived, the two teachers will take them to the studio where they can leave their jackets and bags. Afterwards, the pedagogues take the children to the nearest toilet (handicapped accessible toilet on the ground floor), where the children wash their hands.
- Throughout the house, the direction of movement is prescribed by a guidance system, which avoids encounter traffic. Supervisors also ensure that the direction of walking is observed. It cannot be ensured that the children participate in the event exclusively sitting down, as the essence of the offer is to move through the rooms.
- The exhibition rooms are ventilated continuously by means of a (fresh air) air conditioning system.
- Disinfection dispensers are located at all intersections.
- The exhibition halls offer eight children sufficient space (a total of 1100 square meters) to keep a minimum distance of 1.5 meters between the persons according to § a paragraph (3) sentence 1 and 2.

Hygiene concept for "Kestnerkids sehen Kunst" pursuant to the Ordinance of Lower Saxony on the Reorganisation of Measures against the Spread of the Corona Virus SARS-CoV-2 of 10 July 2020, as amended on 31 July 2020

Measures for the preparation of the event

- There are eight places available.
- The children announce themselves under kestnerkids@kestnergesellschaft.de. The personal registration includes the child's first name, surname, address and telephone number. The data will be kept for at least three weeks.
- The exhibition halls and adjoining rooms in which the children will be moving are 1,300 square meters in total. The number of participating children is limited to 8 children, plus one educator.

Procedure and measures during the event

- The children arrive individually in the foyer of the Kestner Gesellschaft and register at the reception with their names.
- When entering the Kestner Gesellschaft, they are obliged to wear a mouth and nose mask from the age of 7. The mask must be worn during the entire event.
- The educator also wears a mask.
- As soon as all eight children have arrived, they will be taken by the educator to the studio where they can take off their jackets. Afterwards, the pedagogue leads the children to the nearest toilet (handicapped accessible toilet on the ground floor), where the children wash their hands. Afterwards the children explore the exhibition for an hour with the teacher.
- A guidance system is used throughout the building to determine the direction in which the children are to walk, thus avoiding encounter traffic. Supervisors also make sure that the direction of travel is observed.
- It cannot be ensured that the children participate in the event exclusively sitting down, as the essence of the program is to move through the rooms.
- The exhibition rooms are ventilated continuously by an air conditioning system.
- Disinfection dispensers are located at all junctions.
- The exhibition halls offer eight children sufficient space to keep the minimum distance of 1.5 meters between the persons according to § a paragraph (3) sentence 1 and 2.
- The pedagogue takes care that the distances are maintained at all times. After the end of the event, the group moves into the foyer. The children are picked up there or go home on their own.

Hygiene concept for "vacation workshop" pursuant to the Ordinance of Lower Saxony on the Reorganisation of Measures against the Spread of the Corona Virus SARS-CoV-2 of 10 July 2020, as amended on 31 July 2020

Measures for the preparation of the event

- There are eight places available.
- The children must register bindingly up to one week in advance by e-mail at kestnerkids@kestnergesellschaft.de. The personal registration includes the child's first name, surname, address and telephone number. The data will be kept for the duration of at least three weeks.
- The exhibition halls and adjoining rooms in which the children move around are 1,300 square meters in total. The studio is 60 square meters. The number of participating children is limited to 8 children, plus 2 teachers.

Procedure and measures during the event

- On the first and second day of the vacation workshop, the children arrive individually in the foyer of the Kestner Gesellschaft and register at the reception with their names.
- When entering the Kestner Gesellschaft, children over 7 years of age are required to wear a mouth and nose mask. The mask must be worn during the entire event.
- The teachers also wear a mask.
- As soon as all eight children have arrived, the two teachers will take them to the studio where they can leave their jackets and bags. Afterwards the pedagogues lead the children to the nearest toilet (handicapped accessible toilet on the ground floor) where the children wash their hands.
- During the day the group explores the exhibition and gets creative in the studio. They either stay together or split up between the two teachers.
- When the group moves around the exhibition, it follows the guiding system. Throughout the building, the direction of movement is prescribed by a guidance system that avoids encounter traffic. Supervisors also ensure that the direction of movement is observed.
- The group is divided so that four children and one educator remain in the exhibition halls and four children and one educator work in the studio (60 square meters).
- The studio has three tilting windows and two always open entrances. In addition, all exhibition rooms and the studio are ventilated by air conditioning.
- Each child will be assigned their own material.
- Before the group works with material, the hands must be disinfected.
- The teachers will make sure that the distances are maintained at all times. Depending on the creative action the children sit at tables.
